ally ranked opponents ... the Crusaders, from Nampa, Idaho, are led by 5-9 Jr. G Ellie Logan (12.5 ppg, 3.8 rpg, 2.5 apg, .488 FG, .816 FT) and 5-11 Jr. G Lexi Tubbs (10.5 ppg, 5.2 rpg, .362 3FG) ... racked recently by the injury bug, Seattle Pacific snapped a 5-game losing skid with a 70-60 win in its regular-season finale to secure the No. 5 seed in the GNAC Tournament and keep its slim NCAA Tournament hopes alive ... the Falcons, who started 11-0 and reached as high as No. 5 nationally in the D2CCA Top 25 poll, are led by 6-0 Jr. G Courtney Hollander (12.2 ppg, 7.1 rpg, 2.0 apg, .326 3FG, .851 FT) and 5-10 Jr. G Jordan McPhee (11.0 ppg, 5.3 rpg, 2.0 apg, .792 FT).

UAA has won 13 of the last 14 overall, including its two largest margins ever vs. SPU in the last two games in Anchorage (82-47 last year) ... teams have met 23 times since Jan. 2008, including three times in the NCAA Division II West Regionals and once in the GNAC Tournament – a 68-66 UAA home win in the 2011 semifinals ... SPU leads 18-14 in GNAC regular-season meetings, taking the first 11 encounters ... SPU is UAA's 2nd-most common opponent, squaring off at least once per season since 1990-91 ... series started in 1979-80.

WHAT'S AT STAKE: With no losses against fellow NCAA Div. II opponents, the Seawolves have a 2-game advantage in the loss column over regionally 2nd-ranked Cal Baptist, which will aim for the Pac West Tournament title at the same time this week ... with only one loss mathematically possible this week, that leaves the Seawolves theoretically in command of the race for home-court advantage for the Mar. 10-13 NCAA West Regional Championships ... Western Washington and Simon Fraser have likely secured NCAA Tournament bids, while Northwest Nazarene, Seattle Pacific and Central Washington all definitely (NNU & CWU) or probably (SPU) win the GNAC Tourney to gain NCAA entry.

NCAA ANNOUNCEMENT SUNDAY: The Seawolves and the rest of the Div. II college basketball world will learn their NCAA Tournament fates on Sunday, Mar. 5, when the 64-team national playoff field is unveiled at 6 p.m. AST on ncaa.com.

GNAC TOURNEY HISTORY: The Seawolves have captured four of the first six GNAC Tournament titles ... UAA has a 9-2 record in GNAC Tourney games, including 4-0 marks in both the semifinal and final rounds ... last year UAA blasted Simon Fraser 82-47 in the semifinals behind 17 points apiece from **Alysha**

Devine and Megan Mullings, **Sierra Afoa** grabbed 8 rebounds ... the next night, UAA got a tougher test from 3rd-seeded MSU Billings before pulling away for a 77-57 win behind 13 points and 4 assists from Keiahnna Engel ... **Kiki Robertson** tied the tourney record with 9 assists – along with 5 points and 5 rebounds – to earn Tournament MVP honors for the second straight year, while Jenna Buchanan and Jessica Madison scored 12 points each.

WINNING WAYS: UAA's 23-game win streak has surpassed the 22 straight by the 2008-09 squad for the longest in program history ... the Seawolves are also currently on program-best streaks of 27 straight wins vs. Div. II opponents, 21 consecutive road wins, and 18 straight conference road wins ... UAA is a combined 59-3 – including 28-1 on the road – in GNAC regular-season and tournament games over the last three seasons ... at 94-6 (.940), the Seawolves have the most victories and the best winning percentage in NCAA Div. II since 2014-15 ... over the last decade, the Seawolves' 257 victories are also the most in women's D-II hoops, surpassing Emporia State in January ... the 2016-17 Seawolves have claimed the program's 11th consecutive winning season and will almost certainly earn a 10th NCAA Tournament berth in 11 years ... UAA has gone a combined 155-14 (.917) in the last 11 seasons on its home courts ... after a 7-0 mark this fall, UAA has won 36 straight regular-season, non-conference games against Div. II opponents, with the last loss coming in Ryan McCarthy's Seawolf coaching debut, Nov. 9, 2012 (Colo. Mines) ... the Seawolves have led the nation in steals per game for three straight seasons, with 14.3 spg in 2013-14, a program-record 15.0 in 2014-15, and 13.6 last year.

STEALING THE SHOW: With 16.1 steals per game, the Seawolves are making a bid to lead NCAA Div. II in that category a fourth straight season, currently boasting a solid edge over Cal-Pa. (15.4 spg) for the top spot ... all told, UAA is in the top 25 nationally in a dozen categories, ranking 2nd in turnovers forced per game (26.3), scoring margin (+30.0), turnover margin (+11.6) and assists per game (19.5), 3rd in scoring defense (52.8), 5th scoring offense (82.8 ppg), 6th in A/T ratio (+1.33), 12th in FT% (.776), 16th in FG% (.451), 23rd in 3FG per game (8.2) and 25th in 3FG% (.365) ... in the GNAC stats, the Seawolves lead in 13 of 21 categories and rank 2nd or 3rd in six others.

HAWAIIAN PUNCH: Sr. PG **Kiki Robertson** is UAA's 2nd-leading scorer at 8.6 ppg and continued to add to her All-America credentials last week with clutch performances in the road victories at WWU and SFU last week ... the two-time reigning GNAC Tournament MVP ranks among the league's top 3 in four different categories – 1st in steals (3.4 spg), 2nd in assists (5.5 apg), and 3rd in A/T ratio (2.5) and FT% (.867) ... in the national stats, she ranks 6th in spg, 21st in apg and 12th in A/T ratio – one of two players in the top 25 in all three categories – as well as 20th in FT% ... the 3-time 2nd Team All-GNAC performer started the season as UAA's career assists leader and claimed the GNAC record in the first game this year; now with 681, she is tied for 24th place on the all-time NCAA Div. II list ... with five swipes against Northwest Nazarene on Jan. 14, she added both the UAA and GNAC career

steals record as well, now with 369 ... now UAA's all-time victories leader with 113, Robertson is also on pace to break the Seawolf record for assists per game (5.4), while threatening the mark for steals per game (2nd, 2.9); on the other Seawolf career lists, she is 2nd in games started (124), 16th in scoring (987 pts), 7th in FT% (.789), 10th in FTs made (247) and tied for 3rd in games played (127) ... among the NCAA Div. II active career leader, she leads in assists and ranks 2nd steals, plus 3rd in both apg and spg ... the only Hawaiian ever to suit up for the Seawolves, Robertson was the GNAC Defensive Player of the Year as a sophomore in 2014-15.

FALLING FOR AUTUMMN: Sr. F **Autummn Williams** has emerged as UAA's latest candidate for All-America honors, ranking 6th nationally in scoring with 21.1 points per game, boosted by three 30-plus performances in the last six games ... the transfer from Div. I Little Rock has hit the 20-point plateau 16 times, including 11 of the last 14 games, and been UAA's top scorer in 25 of 28 contests ... Williams has shot at least 50 percent 18 times, dished at least 3 assists 20 times, and grabbed multiple steals 11 times ... with back-to-back honors in December and February, Williams became just the third player in GNAC history and the first since 2008-09 to win **four GNAC Player of the Week awards** in the same season, and she picked up **USBWA National Player of the Week** for her efforts at Northwest Nazarene and Central Washington ... Williams holds GNAC ranks of 2nd in steals (2.6 spg, 39th nationally), 2nd in scoring, 5th in FG% (.511, 40th nationally), 11th in assists (3.1 apg), 7th in A/T ratio (1.5), 8th in 3FGs per game (1.7) and 8th in 3FG% (.378) ... Williams's 28.5 minutes per game are also the most averaged by a Seawolf since Kylie Burns logged 30.2 mpg in 2013-14.
