### Seawolves reach National Title Match, win GNAC in record 34-3 campaign

2016 UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA ANCHORAGE VOLLEYBALL  
SEASON-END RELEASE

**BRIEF SEASON RECAP:** The 2016 Alaska Anchorage volleyball team recorded the best season in program history, reaching the NCAA Div. II National Title Match and earning its second straight Great Northwest Athletic Conference outright title, while posting records of 34-3 overall and 19-1 in league ... among their 40 school records included marks for most victories, longest win streak (20) and most consecutive NCAA Tournament berths (4) as the Seawolves won their first West Region title ... led by **National Coach of the Year Chris Green** and **GNAC** and **West Region player-of-the-year Morgan Hooe**, UAA posted seven wins over nationally ranked opponents and went 33-1 from Aug. 27-Dec. 9, with that lone loss coming in a 20-18 fifth set against the league runner-up ... in addition to All-America honors for Hooe and So. OH **Leah Swiss**, right-side hitter **Diana Fa'amausili** was tabbed the **GNAC** and **West Region freshman of the year**.

**ELITE EIGHT RECAP:** The Seawolves reached their first NCAA Div. II Elite Eight in program history in 2016, earning the No. 6 seed for the national quarterfinal, semifinal and final rounds, Dec. 8-10 at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls, South Dakota ... the nationally 9th-ranked Seawolves posted 4-set wins over 12th-ranked Angelo State and 10th-ranked Palm Beach Atlantic to earn a berth in their first NCAA Title Match, where they fell in straight sets to top-ranked and 8-time national champion Concordia St. Paul ... against No. 3 seed ASU, So. OH **Chrisalyn Johnson** and So. OH **Leah Swiss** combined for 39 kills and 33 digs, while Sr. S **Morgan Hooe** had 46 assists and a career-high 19 digs to help overcome a bumpy first set in a 14-25, 25-22, 27-25, 25-16 victory ... Fr. RS **Diana Fa'amausili** added 7 kills on .286 hitting and 7 blocks, account-

ing for three straight points to finish off the third set, and So. L **Kyla Militante-Amper** had 26 digs and 4 assists ... in the semis against No. 2 seed PBA, Johnson had 17 kills, 14 digs and 3 blocks, including the match-point kill to cap a 25-16, 19-25, 25-17, 25-22 victory over the defending national runners-up ... Hooe finished with 51 assists, 16 digs and 3 kills, Swiss had 14 kills and 12 digs, and Fa'amausili tallied 13 kills and 3 blocks, while So. MB **Vanessa Hayes** notched 4 blocks a tied her season high with 8 kills, and So. DS **Taylor Noga** made a career-high 19 digs ... in the finals against CSP, Swiss had 8 kills on .280 hitting, but UAA suffered just its second straight-set loss in 73 matches, falling 25-19, 25-12, 25-12 to the Bears ... Hooe and Johnson were both named to the **All-NCAA Tournament Team**.

**WEST REGION CHAMPS:** The nationally 9th-ranked and regionally top-seeded Seawolves earned their program's first regional title with a wins over Chico State, Northwest Nazarene and 16th-ranked Western Washington in the West Regional Championships at the Alaska Airlines Center, Dec. 1-3 ... after an impressive sweep of Chico State (25-21, 25-18, 25-15) in the first round, UAA needed a dramatic comeback to fend off 5th-seeded and GNAC rival Northwest Nazarene (25-17, 22-25, 25-21, 23-25, 15-10) in the regional semis ... trailing 9-5 in the 5th set against NNU, So. OH **Leah Swiss** ripped six kills and Sr. MB **Erin Braun** accounted for three points in the final 11 rallies to earn UAA's first-ever NCAA 2nd Round victory ... Swiss finished with 21 kills and 14 digs, Braun had 12 kills and a UAA season-high 9 total blocks, and Sr. S **Morgan Hooe** accounted for a career-high 60 assists, career-high-tying 5 total blocks, 5 kills and 14 digs ... in Saturday's finale, Swiss had 16 kills and 12 digs, and Hooe made a dramatic return from injury to power a 19-25, 27-25, 25-21, 25-23 win over 16th-ranked and 3rd-seeded Western Washington in the regional final ... after going down with a leg injury 11 points into the match, Hooe came back in with UAA trailing by a set and down 3-4 in the 2nd, before finishing with 39 assists, 3 kills, 13 digs and 2 aces ... Braun had 15 kills on .424 hitting, So. OH **Chrisalyn Johnson** had 10 kills and a career-high 24 digs, and So. L **Kyla Militante-Amper** tied the old UAA single-match digs record of 39 that she had broken earlier this season ... the Seawolves needed another late rally to overcome the arch-rival and defending region champ Vikings, too -- down 21-23 in the 4th, UAA used a Viking service error and a Johnson kill to tie it, followed by an ace by Hooe and another kill by Johnson ... Hooe, Swiss, Braun and Fr. RS **Diana Fa'amausili** gave UAA four of the 12 honorees on the West Regional Championships **All-Tournament Team**.

**SEAWOLF NCAA HISTORY:** The Seawolves earned their deepest NCAA Tournament run by making the national final, winning multiple matches for the first time this year ... UAA made its program-record fourth straight NCAA appearance and seventh in eight seasons ... this year marked UAA's ninth overall NCAA Tournament trip (1989, 1990, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016), with its overall record improving to 7-9 ... UAA has now won two straight First Round matches after losing four in a row between 2010-14 ... the Seawolves were a No. 2 seed in 2014 and earned the No. 1 seed in 2015 and 2016 – the program's three best seedings ever ... UAA was the No. 5 seed in 2009 when it earned its first NCAA win with a 5-set 1st Round victory over Hawaii-Hilo in San Bernardino, Calif.



**A HOWL LOTTA LOVE:** UAA led NCAA Div. II Volleyball in attendance for the second straight season, with its 1,387 per game far outdistancing Angelo State ... the Seawolves drew five of the top seven single-match attendance totals in 2016, with their 2,710 for the West Regional final standing as the program record and the second-highest attendance for any D-II match since 2013.

**TEAM NOTES:** Among their 40 program team and individual records in 2016, the Seawolves broke the marks victories and winning percentage set by last year's 27-3 squad ... the 2016 Seawolves also put up team records for most road wins (13), most consecutive wins (20), most consecutive sweeps (6), most consecutive sets won (22) and highest AVCA national ranking (No. 3 in final poll) ... the five longest win streaks in program history have all occurred since head coach **Chris Green's** second season in 2009 ... the Seawolves led the GNAC stats in opponent attack pct. (.127) and aces per set (1.61), and ranked 2nd in kills per set (13.94), blocks per set (2.39) and attack pct. (.225) ... in the NCAA Div. II national stats, UAA ranked no lower than 40th (among 292 teams) in seven of the eight major statistical categories, including 7th in blocking, 12th in opponent attack pct. and 17th in kills per set ... boosted by its NCAA Tournament run, UAA went 7-2 this season against AVCA Top 25 teams and is 15-5 against ranked teams since 2014 ... UAA is 25-32 against ranked opponents under Green, having lost 32 straight prior to his arrival in 2008 ... UAA has gone 18-1 against non-conference opponents over the last two regular seasons, including 7-0 in neutral-court matches ... UAA has won 26 straight September matches since a 3-1 loss at then-No. 23 NW Nazarene, Sept. 25, 2014, and the Seawolves completed their second straight perfect November slate (6-0 in 2015 and 2016) ... UAA's loss at Chaminade ended

**THE HOOE PACKAGE:** Sr. S Morgan Hooe completed her 4-year career as the most decorated player in UAA Volleyball history, earning **D2CCA West Region Player of the Year, GNAC Player of the Year, All-West Region First Team (AVCA & D2CCA)** and **West Regional Championships All-Tournament Team** honors in the month of November alone ... a 2015 AVCA Third Team All-American and

now **2-time All-GNAC** selection, the former South Anchorage HS star was among the most efficient players in the nation this year, quarterbacking a UAA team that outthit its opponents .225 to .127, boosted by her own .346 attack percentage ... Hooe was at her best in UAA's playoff victories, dishing a career-high 60 assists in the 5-set regional semifinal thriller over NW Nazarene, then returning from injury to lead UAA past rival Western Washington with 39 assists, 13 digs, 3 kills and 2 aces in the regional final ... Hooe earned GNAC Offensive Player of the Week honors for her effort at home against Western Oregon and Concordia, and she followed with 52 and 56 assists in wins at NCAA qualifiers Central Washington and NNU ... along with 10.61 assists per set, Hooe put up 1.16 kps, 2.85 dps and 0.35 bps ... with 153 kills and 26 attack errors, she committed multiple attack errors only four times all season, while hitting .500 or better 15 times ... the Most Outstanding Player of the SpringHill Suites Invitational racked up 47 assists in the win over No. 19 Arkansas Fort Smith and led UAA to a .258 attack pct. in those four matches, Sept. 1-3 ... Hooe also dished 47 assists in September wins over ranked foes Cal St. San Bernardino and WWU ... Braun finished with GNAC ranks of 5th in attack pct. (.300) and 6th in bps, connecting for at least 5 kills on .300-plus hitting on 22 occasions, including a career- and GNAC season-high .706 (12-0-17) against Western Oregon ... the San Bernardino, Calif., native posted at least four kills in 60 of 67 matches over her final two seasons, along with 27 performances with 5-plus blocks in that span ... **FA'ABULOUS FRESHMEN:** Fr. RS Diana Fa'amausili and Fr. MB Vanessa Hayes wasted no time in contributing to the regular rotation despite their rookie status, combining for 3.97 kills and 1.99 blocks per set ... the *AVCA West Region Freshman of the Year, GNAC Freshman of the Year* and the *only freshman on the All-GNAC* team, Fa'amausili was UAA's 2nd-leading blocker with 1.05 bps, ranking 8th in the GNAC, 56th nationally overall and 5th nationally among freshmen (2nd among right sides) ... Fa'amausili delivered at least 5 kills in all 37 matches, averaging 2.75 kps on .260

hitting, and picking up her first GNAC Defensive Player of the Week for her play at home against NNU and CWU ... meanwhile, Hayes was a consistent presence all season, notching multiple kills and multiple blocks in 27 of 37 matches ... the Salem, Ore. (McNary HS) native hit .364 with 6 kills and 5 block assists in the win over No. 15 Cal St. San Bernardino, and she delivered her two of her best attack percentages in UAA's road victories at Simon Fraser and No. 20 Western Washington, combining for 13 kills on .462 hitting in those seven sets ... Hayes equaled her season-high 8 kills for the fourth time against Palm Beach Atlantic, and she ranked 11th in the GNAC with 0.95 bps.

**GREEN MACHINE:** Having led UAA to its unprecedented ninth straight winning season, UAA head coach **Chris Green** (193-72, .728) continues to establish himself as the most successful coach in program history and one of the top mentors in the NCAA Div. II ranks, capturing the **2016 AVCA D-II National Coach of the Year** award ... now a **4-time GNAC Coach of the Year** (2009, 2013, 2015, 2016) and **2-time AVCA D-II West Region Coach of the Year** (2009, 2015), Green has led UAA to NCAA Tournament berths in seven of the last eight seasons, capturing the program's highest-ever seeds the last three years ... in the 28 years before Green's arrival, the Seawolves made two NCAAAs ... UAA has won at an .824 clip (103-22) since the start of the 2013 campaign, including .882 (67-9) in league play ... after helping the Seawolves to a 10-win turnaround in his first season, Green earned both GNAC and NCAA Div. II West Region coach-of-the-year honors in 2009 when he piloted UAA to its first GNAC title and the program's first-ever NCAA victory ... Green's UAA teams have produced six All-Americans, five GNAC Players of the Year, five GNAC Newcomers of the Year and three GNAC Freshmen of the Year ... hired in Feb. 2008 as the sixth coach in UAA Volleyball history, Green spent the previous nine seasons (1999-07) as the head coach at Western Nebraska Community College, where he built a powerhouse program. Among his list of accomplishments at WNCC were a 453-55 record, the 2007 NJCAA Div. I national championship, 2006 NJCAA runner-up, and four straight 'Final 4' berths ... the Cougars finished in the top 10 at the national tournament in all of Green's seasons, producing a total of 10 first-team and six second-team All-America certificates ... in 2011, he was inducted into the NJCAA Hall of Fame ... Green's 2016 staff was comprised of 2nd-year assistant coach **Sheldon Carvalho** – the **AVCA Div. II National Assistant Coach of the Year** – along with 2nd-year graduate assistant coach **Calli Scott**, and volunteer assistants **Gaynor Johansen** (7th season), **Siobhan Johansen** (3rd season), **Virgil Hooe** (1st season) and **Nathan Svedin** (1st season).
