KNOW THE FOES: Contending for an NCAA playoff spot through mid-January, **Concordia-Portland** is now focused on earning its first-ever GNAC Tournament berth after losing six of its last seven ... the Cavaliers are led by Sr. G Danielle Hartzog (16.0 ppg, 3.8 rpg, 2.3 apg, 1.5 spg, .728 FT) and 6-1 Jr. F Bailey Cartwright (13.6 ppg, GNAC-best 10.5 rpg, 1.0 bpg, .738 FT) ... **Western Oregon** won three of five games to start the 2018 calendar but will try to snap a 5-game losing skid when it hosts Alaska Fairbanks on Thursday ... the Wolves are led by Sr. F Savannah Heugly (11.8 ppg, 5.8 rpg, 2.0 spg, .771 FT) and Sr. G Sydney Azorr (9.6 ppg, 3.8 rpg, .881 FT).

LAST TIME VS. OREGON SCHOOLS: UAA ran its program-record win streak to 28 in a row against Western Oregon and stayed unbeaten in five all-time meetings against Concordia-Portland with respective 85-53 and 76-58 victories at the Alaska Airlines Center on Jan. 11 and Jan. 13 ... in the first game, Jr. G **Kian McNair** scored a career-high 15 points (3-3 3FG, 6-6 FT), Sr. G **Kaitlyn Hurley** had 13 points (3-6 3FG) and 5 assists, and Jr. C **Hannah Wandersee** scored 12 points to race past the Wolves ... Fr. G **Nicole Pinckney** sparked the early offense with a career-high 9 points, and fellow rookie **Sala Langi** tied her then-personal bests with 9 points and 7 rebounds ... on Saturday, the Seawolves were challenged until the final minute in a battle with the regionally 7th-ranked Cavs, getting 18 points (7-14 FG) and 8 rebounds from Wandersee, 13 points and 9 assists from So. PG **Yazmeen Goo**, and clutch shooting from Sr. G **Tara Thompson** (11 points, 3-3 3FG in final 6 minutes) to pull out the win ... Langi had another solid effort with a career-high 10 points (4-5 FG).

SEAWOLVES STAY PERFECT AT HOME: The Seawolves completed a sweep of their four-game homestand and improved to 11-0 at the Alaska Airlines Center with a 63-46 win over Alaska Fairbanks on Jan. 30 and a 73-63 victory over regionally 7th-ranked Montana State Billings on Feb. 1 ... in the first game, Sr. F **Shelby Cloninger** collected 15 points (5-10 FG, 3-4 3FG) and 6 rebounds on her way to **GNAC Player of the Week** honors, and Jr. C **Hannah Wandersee** had 14 points (7-12 FG) rebounds ... Sr. G **Rodericka Ware** chipped in 11 of her 12 points before halftime and dished 5 assists as UAA beat UAF for the 22nd time in a row ... on Thursday, Cloninger had 21 points – including the clinching jumper with 1:06 remaining – and 10 rebounds to help UAA fend off the Yellowjackets for their ninth straight win in the series ... Wandersee had 14 points and 8 rebounds, Fr. G **Sala Langi** tallied 9 points (4-6 FG) and 4 rebounds, and Jr. G **Kian McNair** delivered 6 points, a career-high 7 rebounds, 5 assists, no turnovers and 4 steals as UAA outrebounded the visitors 46-31.

WINNING WAYS: The Seawolves' loss at SPU snapped GNAC regular-season win streaks of 33 overall (including GNAC Tourney), 29 overall (not including GNAC Tourney) and 23 straight on the road ... UAA has won 18 consecutive GNAC home contests ... UAA is a combined 74-4 – including 33-2 on the road – in GNAC regular-season and tournament games over the last four seasons ... at 117-9 (.929), the Seawolves have the most victories and the best winning percentage in NCAA Div. II since 2014-15 ... the Seawolves have clinched the program's 12th consecutive winning season and are seeking their 11th NCAA Tournament berth in 12 years ... UAA has gone a combined 166-14 (.922) in the last 11 seasons on its home courts ... the loss to Sonoma State snapped a 41-game winning streak against Div. II non-conference opponents in the regular season, marking the first such setback since Ryan McCarthy's Seawolf coaching debut, Nov. 9, 2012, against Colorado Mines.

NIFTY NUMBERS: The Seawolves hold nine top-50 national stats ranks, including six top-20 marks ... UAA is 3rd in steals per game (14.5), 4th in assists per game (19.6), 9th in turnovers forced per game (23.4), 11th in turnover margin (+7.4), and 20th in assist/turnover ratio (1.2) and scoring margin (+5.7) ... the Seawolves are attempting to lead the nation in steals for the fifth consecutive season, although they currently trail defending national champ Ashland (18.1) by a wide margin ... in the GNAC stats, UAA leads in six categories and ranks No. 2 in four others.

SURE-SHOT SHELBY: Sr. F **Shelby Cloninger** has proven GNAC coaches correct so far as a **GNAC Preseason All-Conference** pick, standing as UAA's leading scorer (14.5 ppg) and rebounder (6.7 rpg) ... with 16 double-figure scoring efforts in her 19 appearances – including successive career highs of 19 points against Div. I Maryland Eastern Shore, 22 at UAF and 26 at Simon Fraser – she holds GNAC ranks of 5th in scoring, 9th in rebounding, 2nd in FT% (.882), 5th in FG% (.493), 1st in 3FG% (.427), 10th in 3FGs per game (1.7) and 17th in steals per game (1.4) ... the Kamiah, Idaho, native also has 10 games with at least 7 rebounds this year, including 10 against MSU Billings and Western State, nine at Simon Fraser and at Seattle Pacific, and a career-high 12 at Western Washington ... in late November, Cloninger claimed **GCI Great Alaska Shootout Most Outstanding Player** and GNAC Player of the Week honors after leading the Seawolves to the final tournament title, and she picked up the GNAC weekly award for Jan. 29-Feb. 4 for her effort in home wins over UAF and MSUB ... a transfer from North Idaho College after playing at Div. I Utah State, Cloninger holds UAA career ranks of 3rd in FT% (.824) and 11th in both 3FGs per game (1.3) and 3FG% (.366).

WANDERSEE WONDERFUL: A reserve in 66 of 71 career games before this year, Jr. C **Hannah Wandersee** has entered the starting 5 and delivered in a big way, ranking 10th in the GNAC in scoring (13.5 ppg), leading the league in blocks (1.3 bpg), and ranking 3rd in FG% (.506), 13th in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and 17th in FT% (.750) ... she collected GNAC co-Player of the Week for her efforts against Hawaii Pacific and Cal State LA, earned the Seawolf Hoops Classic Most Outstanding Player award the following week, and made the GCI Great Alaska Shootout All-Tournament Team – in November alone ... the Kodiak product had her first career double-double against a Div. II opponent with 24 points and 11 rebounds against Hawaii Pacific, and she grabbed her second (16 pts/career-high 13 rebs) in the win at Saint Martin's ... her career-high 27-point effort against Northwest Nazarene marked her third career 20-plus game ... with more than a year to play, Wandersee already owns UAA career top-10 marks in FT% (7th, .800), (FG%,

TNT BLOWIN' UP: Whether it's her deadeye three-point stroke or her solid all-around game, Jr. G **Tara (N.) Thompson** has lived up to her **GNAC Preseason All-Conference** status, currently checking in as UAA's 5th-leading scorer with 7.3 ppg ... the 2nd-leading

scorer (8.9 ppg) on last year's 30-win team and a bench contributor on UAA's 2016 NCAA Runner-Up squad, Thompson ranks 5th in the GNAC with her .400 3FG%, boosted by an 8-of-12 effort in the win at Notre Dame de Namur and a school-record-tying 6-of-6 display at MSU Billings ... the former Dimond High star led the GNAC in 3FG% last season and currently holds league ranks of 5th in 3FG% and 4th in 3FGs per game (1.9) ... with a .400 career 3FG%, Thompson ranks 6th in UAA history and top 10 in GNAC history, while her 152 total 3FGs are also 6th on the all-time Seawolf list.

PG **Yazmeen Goo** has blossomed into a scoring threat as well, tallying double figures in seven of the last 17 games – including successive career-highs of 11 points against Western State, 13 points against Northwest Nazarene, 14 at Western Washington and 15 at Saint Martin's ... the Bay Area native earned all-tournament honors at both the Seawolf Hoops Classic and the GCI Great Alaska Shootout, while her 75 free throws made are 7th-most in the GNAC ... in the other GNAC stats, Goo is 2nd in both steals per game (2.9 spg, 22nd nationally) and assist-turnover ratio (2.0, 43rd nationally), and 5th in assists per game (4.1) ... Goo and UAA have also gotten a boost with the return of Sr. SG **Kaitlyn Hurley**, who missed the second half of last season ... a dangerous scorer from anywhere on the court, Hurley has started eight of 22 contests, posting 5.7 ppg, 2.4 rpg and 1.6 apg, along with eight blocked shots ... the Utah native and Snow College transfer scored a season-high 16 points in the win over Div. I Maryland Eastern Shore, and she had a clutch performance in the win at Western Washington with 10 points (4-7 FG, 2-3 3FG), no turnovers and no fouls in 19 minutes.
