Notes: SPU's win in Seattle last month snapped an 11-game losing skid to UAA and was the Falcons' largest margin of victory since Feb. 23, 2006 ... UAA's 11-game streak was its longest against SPU and 4th-longest against any opponent ... UAA has won 14 of the last 16 overall, including 94-50 at home last year ... the teams have met 26 times since Jan. 2008, including three times in the NCAA Division II West Regionals and twice in the GNAC Tournament ... SPU leads 19-14 in GNAC regular-season meetings (since 2001-02), taking the first 11 encounters ... UAA leads 11-1 under head coach Ryan McCarthy ... SPU is UAA's 2nd-most common opponent, squaring off at least once per season since 1990-91 ... series started in 1979-80.

LAST TIME VS. SMU, SPU: The Seawolves extended their bevy of GNAC winning streaks with a 76-57 victory over Saint Martin's on Jan. 18 in Lacey, Wash., before succumbing to a red-hot Seattle Pacific club, 66-48, on Jan. 20 in Seattle ... in the first game, Jr. C **Hannah Wandersee** had 16 points and a career-high 13 rebounds, teaming with So. PG **Yazmeen Goo** to lead then-No. 4 UAA to its eighth straight win at Marcus Pavilion (including GNAC tourneys) ... Goo finished with a career-high 15 points, plus 5 assists and 5 steals, to spark the Seawolves in the 3rd quarter, while Sr. G **Kaitlyn Hurley** tallied 15 points (5-11 3FG) ... two days later, UAA suffered its most lopsided loss in five years, falling to the Falcons despite 13 points and 9 rebounds from Sr. F **Shelby Cloninger**, who returned the lineup from a 3-game injury absence ... UAA also got 12 points from Wandersee as it dropped a GNAC regular-season or tournament game for the first time since a 67-66 loss to Simon Fraser on Feb. 27, 2016 at the Alaska Airlines Center ... the Seawolves shot just 26.4 percent and were outrebounded 46-30 as they saw a 23-game GNAC road winning streak halted, while the 18-point margin

SEAWOLVES SURVIVE OREGON TRAIL: UAA was pushed to the limit by Concordia-Portland and Western Oregon before pulling off a pair of road wins last week in the Beaver State ... on Thursday, Jr. C **Hannah Wandersee** had 14 points, 7 rebounds and 3 blocks, and Sr. F **Shelby Cloninger** scored 12 of her 15 points in the 2nd quarter to pace a 73-69 overtime victory over the Cavs ... Sr. G **Rodericka Ware** added 10 points and a career-high rebounds, while So. PG **Yazmeen Goo** totaled 9 points, 8 assists, 4 steals and just 2 turnovers as UAA stayed unbeaten in six meetings against CU ... in Monmouth, Wandersee exploded for a career-high 32 points (11-19 FG, 10-13 FT) and grabbed 9 rebounds (6 offensive) to help the visitors overcome a 21-12 deficit and beat the Wolves for the program-record 29th consecutive time ... Goo had another solid effort with 13 points (5-6 FG), 4 assists, 4 steals and no turnovers, while Ware tallied double digits again with 11 points (3-7 3FG).

WINNING WAYS: The Seawolves' loss at SPU on Jan. 20 snapped GNAC regular-season win streaks of 33 overall (including GNAC Tourney), 29 overall (not including GNAC Tourney) and 23 straight on the road ... UAA has won 18 consecutive GNAC home contests ... UAA is a combined 76-4 – including 35-2 on the road – in GNAC regular-season and tournament games over the last four seasons ... at 119-9 (.930), the Seawolves have the most victories and the best winning percentage in NCAA Div. II since 2014-15 ... the Seawolves have clinched the program's 12th consecutive winning season and are seeking their 11th NCAA Tournament berth in 12 years ... UAA has gone a combined 166-14 (.922) in the last 11 seasons on its home courts ... the loss to Sonoma State snapped a 41-game winning streak against Div. II non-conference opponents in the regular season, marking the first such setback since Ryan McCarthy's Seawolf coaching debut, Nov. 9, 2012, against Colorado Mines.

NIFTY NUMBERS: The Seawolves hold nine top-50 national stats ranks, including five top-20 marks ... UAA is 4th in steals per game (14.4), 5th in assists per game (19.3), 11th in turnover margin (+7.25), 13th in turnovers forced per game (23.0), 19th in assist/turnover ratio (1.22) and 25th scoring margin (+14.9) ... the Seawolves are attempting to lead the nation in steals for the fifth consecutive season, although they currently trail defending national champ Ashland (18.1) by a wide margin ... in the GNAC stats, UAA leads in six categories and ranks No. 2 in four others.

SURE-SHOT SHELBY: Sr. F **Shelby Cloninger** has proven GNAC coaches correct so far as a **GNAC Preseason All-Conference** pick, standing as UAA's second-leading scorer (13.8 ppg) and leading rebounder (6.5 rpg) ... with 17 double-figure scoring efforts in her 20 appearances – including successive career highs of 19 points against Div. I Maryland Eastern Shore, 22 at UAF and 26 at Simon Fraser – she holds GNAC ranks of 10th in scoring and rebounding, 3rd in FT% (.882), 9th in FG% (.477), 6th in 3FG% (.398) and 11th in 3FGs per game (1.7) ... the Kamiah, Idaho, native also has 11 games with at least 7 rebounds this year, including 10 against MSU Billings and Western State, nine at Simon Fraser and at Seattle Pacific, and a career-high 12 at Western Washington ... in late November, Cloninger claimed **GCI Great Alaska Shootout Most Outstanding Player** and GNAC Player of the Week honors after

leading the Seawolves to the final tournament title, and she picked up the GNAC weekly award for Jan. 29-Feb. 4 for her effort in home wins over UAF and MSUB ... a transfer from North Idaho College after playing at Div. I Utah State, Cloninger holds UAA career ranks of 3rd in FT% (.824) and 11th in both 3FGs per game (1.3) and 3FG% (.357).

WANDERSEE WONDERFUL: A reserve in 66 of 71 career games before this year, Jr. C **Hannah Wandersee** has entered the starting 5 and delivered in a big way, ranking 7th in the GNAC in scoring (14.3 ppg), leading the league in blocks (1.3 bpg), and ranking 3rd in FG% (.511), 12th in rebounding (6.5 rpg) and 17th in FT% (.753) ... she collected GNAC co-Player of the Week for her efforts against Hawaii Pacific and Cal State LA, earned the Seawolf Hoops Classic Most Outstanding Player award the following week, and made the GCI Great Alaska Shootout All-Tournament Team – in November alone ... the Kodiak product had her first career double-double against a Div. II opponent with 24 points and 11 rebounds against Hawaii Pacific, grabbed her second (16 pts/career-high 13 rebs) in the win at Saint Martin's, and just missed a third with 9 rebounds and a career-high 32 points in the 86-78 win at WOU ... along with a 27-point effort against Northwest Nazarene, she now has four career 20-plus games ... with more than a year to play, Wandersee already owns UAA career top-10 marks in FT% (7th, .795), (FG%, 7th, .515), blocks (6th, 72), blocks per game (9th, 0.76) and victories (t-9th, 89).

FEELIN' GOO: Following one of the most productive rookie campaigns for a point guard in program history, So. PG **Yazmeen Goo** has blossomed into a scoring threat as well, tallying double figures in eight of the last 18 games – including successive career-highs of 11 points against Western State, 13 points against Northwest Nazarene, 14 at Western Washington and 15 at Saint Martin's ... the Bay Area native earned all-tournament honors at both the Seawolf Hoops Classic and the GCI Great Alaska Shootout, while her 81 free throws made are 8th-most in the GNAC ... Goo and UAA have also gotten a boost with the return of Sr. SG **Kaitlyn Hurley**, who missed the second half of last season ... a dangerous scorer from anywhere on the court, Hurley has started eight of 24 contests, posting 5.8 ppg, 2.6 rpg and 1.6 apg, along with nine blocked shots ... the Utah native and Snow College transfer scored a season-high 16 points in the win over Div. I Maryland Eastern Shore, and she had a clutch performance in the win at Western Washington with 10 points (4-7 FG, 2-3 3FG), no turnovers and no fouls in 19 minutes.

Ware began her career at Central Arizona College before earning First Team All-Pacific West Conference honors last year with Art U, posting 17.4 ppg, 4.0 apg and a league-leading 2.8 3FGs made per game ... the Lakewood, Wash., native has scored double figures in 10 of 22 games as a Seawolf and dished at least four assists in 10 contests, including 19 points, 5 assists and 5 steals against Holy Names, and 13 points and 6 assists at MSU Billings ... MCCARTHY IN CHARGE: Now in his sixth season at UAA and seventh overall as a head coach, **Ryan McCarthy** has led the Seawolf program to new heights, capturing three straight GNAC regular-season and tournament titles and ascending as high as No. 1 or No. 2 in the national rankings in every season since 2014-15 ... McCarthy earned his second **GNAC Coach of the Year** honor in the last three seasons in 2016-17 and 'three-peated' as the WBCA's NCAA Div. II West Region Coach of the Year ... in 2016-17, the Anchorage native took UAA to the NCAA Tournament for the fourth straight year (including three straight top-2 regional seeds), posting its second straight 30-win season (30-2) and recording the first 20-0 league record in GNAC history ... the previous season, McCarthy's crew set an NCAA Div. II record with 38 victories, advancing all the way to the 2016 National Title Game in Indianapolis ... his 2014-15 club claimed what was then the best winning percentage in program history with a 29-2 (.935) mark, sweeping both GNAC titles as well ... McCarthy has led UAA to an improvement in overall wins (17, 19, 29, 38) his first four seasons and has increased the Seawolves' GNAC victory total every year (11, 12, 17, 18, 20) ... playing its up-tempo 'Mayhem' style, McCarthy's 2016-17 crew has also led the nation in steals per game for four straight seasons ... McCarthy sports a head-coaching record of 155-28 (.847) at UAA and 169-41 (.805) overall, having served in an interim capacity at Northwest Nazarene in 2011-12 ... McCarthy is assisted by 6th-year associate head coach **Shaina Afoa**, 1st-year assistant and former Seawolf standout **Alysha Devine**, and 4th-year volunteer assistant **Patrick Flanigin**.
