### Seawolves go 30-3, win 5th straight GNAC title in 2018-19

#### 2018-19 Alaska Anchorage Women's Basketball Season Review

**BRIEF SEASON RECAP:** The Seawolves produced another banner season, winning their fifth straight Great Northwest Athletic Conference regular-season title, advancing to the NCAA Div. II 'Sweet 16' and finishing No. 7 in the WBCA top 25 coaches' poll ... UAA reached 30 wins for the third time in four seasons, finishing 30-3 overall and 19-1 in the GNAC, led by league player-of-the-year **Hannah Wandersee** ... fellow senior **Tara Thompson** was a 2nd Team All-GNAC pick as the Seawolves also put together a 21-game winning streak and finished runner-up in the GNAC Tournament.

**WEST REGION RECAP:** The 3rd-seeded Seawolves came within a hair's breadth of advancing to the NCAA Div. II Elite Eight, beating Hawaii Pacific (76-69) and Northwest Nazarene (69-67), before falling 65-63 to Azusa Pacific on a desperation three-point shot at the buzzer in the NCAA Div. II West Regional Championships in La Jolla, Calif., Mar. 15-18 ... against the 6th-seeded Sharks, Sr. C **Hannah Wandersee** poured in 22 points (8-13 FG, 2-2 3FG, 4-4 FT) and grabbed 6 rebounds the Seawolves built an 18-point lead and propeled a late HPU comeback ... Jr. PG **Yazmeen Goo** added 10 points (3-6 FG, 4-6 FT), 4 assists, 2 steals and no turnovers and So. F **Tennae Voliva** had 7 points (3-4 FG) and a career-high 9 rebounds as UAA grabbed 17 offensive boards ... playing NNU for the third time in 17 days in the second round, Sr. G **Tara Thompson** scored a season-high 19 points (6-8 3FG) – including a key late trey – and UAA survived a last-second 3FG try by the 2nd-seeded and nationally 5th-ranked Nighthawks ... Wan-

dersee had 16 points (6-8 FG, 2-2 3FG, 2-2 FT) and 3 blocks, Sr. G **Sydni Stallworth** notched 11 points (3-3 3FG) and 4 assists, and Voliva added 9 points (3-6 FG, 3-4 FT), 5 rebounds and 2 blocks as UAA shot its best 3FG% in the **Ryan McCarthy** era, making 11 of 18 (.611) ... in the title game against 4th-seeded APU, Wandersee had game-highs of 23 points (10-19 FG, 1-1 3FG, 2-2 FT) and 9 rebounds and Thompson hit a go-ahead 3FG with 3.2 seconds remaining, but the Cougars went 9 of 19 from long range, including the game-winner ... Thompson finished with 12 points (4-14 3FG) and 6 rebounds and Sr. G **Kian McNair** dished 7 assists without a turnover as the Seawolves lost a one-possession affair in the regional title game for the second year in a row ... Wandersee was named to the **West Regional All-Tournament Team** for the second year in a row.

**SEAWOLF NCAA HISTORY:** The Seawolves made their 18th overall NCAA Tournament trip ('86, '88, '89, '92, '94, '00, '07, '08, '09, '10, '11, '12, '14, '15, '16, '17, '18, '19) ... UAA stands 26-18 all-time in NCAA games after going 2-1 this March ... UAA is 20-8 in West Region play since 2007, suffering four of those losses to No. 1 seeds (and eventual regional champions) on their home courts (Cal Poly Pomona, '11 & '14; Seattle Pacific, '10; UCSD, '07) ... the Seawolves have won four regional titles (2008, 2009, 2012, 2016) ... UAA made its first appearance in the NCAA Div. II national title game in 2016 after bowing out in the national semifinals in 2008 and 2009 ... UAA improved to 12-6 in NCAA openers and earned its fourth straight first-round win with its 76-69 victory over HPU ... the Seawolves improved 7-8 all-time in the Round of 32 with Saturday's 69-67 win over NNU ... UAA is 4-3 in the Sweet 16 (regional finals) after its 65-63 loss to Azusa Pacific.



**GNAC TOURNEY RECAP:** The Seawolves reached the title game of the ninth annual Great Northwest Athletic Conference Championships last week, but suffered their first loss since Dec. 1 as they fell 70-64 to nationally 9th-ranked Northwest Nazarene on Saturday in Bellingham, Wash. ... in Friday's semifinal against 4th-seeded Central Washington, the top-seeded Seawolves got 21 points (10-18 FG), 7 rebounds, 2 blocks and 3 steals from Sr. C **Hannah Wandersee** to spark a 70-52 win ... Jr. PG **Yazmeen Goo** added 11 points (5-8 FG), 6 rebounds and 4 assists and Jr. G **Safiyah Yasin** had 10 points as UAA beat Central for the 14th straight time ... in the title game, Sr. G **Tara Thompson** equaled her season high with 16 points (4-9 3FG) to lead UAA back from a 38-21 deficit, but the Nighthawks finished with an 11-2 run over the final 5 minutes to claim their first GNAC Tourney crown ... Wandersee had 13 points (6-9 FG) in the loss, while Goo tallied 12 points (3-6 FG, 6-10 FT), 2 assists and 2 steals.



**WINNING WAYS:** The Seawolves won at least 30 games for the third time in four seasons, starting with their NCAA Div. II-record 38 victories in 2015-16 ... UAA became the first basketball program to win at least a share of five straight GNAC regular-season titles ... the 21-game

win streak from Dec. 18-Mar. 8 was the 3rd-longest winning streak in program history ... UAA recorded 25 wins for the fifth straight season and earned its 15th 20-win season in 42 years of program history ... at 154-15 (.911), the Seawolves have the second-best winning percentage and second-most victories in NCAA Div. II since 2014-15, trailing Ashland (157-15, .913) for those honors ... UAA is a combined 99-8 – including 45-4 on the road – in GNAC regular-season and tournament games over the last five seasons (since Dec. 2014) ... the Seawolves have won 30 consecutive GNAC regular-season home contests, posting 10-0 marks the last three seasons ... UAA has gone a combined 182-16 (.919) in the last 12 seasons on its home courts, including 73-6 (.924) at the Alaska Airlines Center (since 2014-15) ... the Seawolves have won 49 of their last 50 regular-season games against Div. II non-conference opponents ... the Seawolves earned the program's 13th consecutive winning season and their 12th NCAA Tournament berth in 13 years ... the Seawolves have won five of the nine GNAC Tournament titles since the event started in 2011.

**NIFTY NUMBERS:** UAA led the GNAC stats in seven categories – scoring defense (56.5 ppg), steals per game (14.6), assists per game (18.0), assist-turnover ratio (1.3), turnover margin (+8.9) and turnovers forced per game (22.8) – while ranking second in scoring margin (+18.5), FG% defense (.385), 3FG% defense (.294) and offensive rebound pct. (.366) ... in the NCAA Div. II national stats, the Seawolves held top-10 ranks in steals per game (2nd), turnover margin (5th), assists per game (5th), turnovers forced per game (8th), A/T ratio (8th) and scoring margin (10th), plus top-50 marks in scoring defense (21st), FG% (35th, .439), scoring offense (32nd), fewest turnovers per game (34th, 13.9) and 3FG% defense (44th) ... the Seawolves combined for 15 team and individual school records in 2018-19, including fewest turnovers per game (13.9), fewest turnovers in a game (4 vs Central Washington, Mar. 2), best individual FT% (.833 by **Hannah Wandersee**) and most 3FGs in a game by a freshman (6 by **Jahnna Hajdukovich** at UAF).

**WONDERFUL WANDERSEE:** The *2018-19 GNAC Player of the Year* and a *two-time unanimous First Team All-GNAC* selection, Sr. C **Hannah Wandersee** racked up honors throughout the regular season, including all-tournament at the Gator Invitational and Seawolf Hoops Classic, MVP of the DII Coast to Coast Classic, and three GNAC Player of the Week awards (Nov. 19-25, Jan. 7-13, Jan. 28-Feb. 3), and in March she collected week *D2CCA First Team All-West Region* and *NCAA West Regional Championships All-Tournament Team* accolades ... UAA's leading scorer and rebounder, she ranked 2nd in scoring (15.0 ppg), 7th in blocks (1.0 bpg), 3rd in FT% (school-record .883), 12th in FG% (.498) and 19th in rebounding (5.2 rpg) in the GNAC stats ... with scoring totals of 21 against Central Washington in the GNAC semifinals, 22 against Hawaii Pacific in the NCAA First Round and 23 against Azusa Pacific in the regional final, the Kodiak product finished with 14 career 20-plus efforts ... one of three players in program history with at least 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks, Wandersee become UAA's all-time leader in both victories (123) and games played (136), along with career top-20 marks in scoring (8th, 1,378), rebounds (10th, 606), blocks (4th, 121), blocks per game (7th, 0.9), FG made (5th, 558), FG% (8th, .512), FT% (3rd, .832) and FT made (12th, 232).

year McCarthy earned his third consecutive **GNAC Coach of the Year** honor and fourth in the last five seasons, while he was the WBCA NCAA Div. II West Region Coach of the Year three straight times from 2015-17 ... in 2016-17, the Anchorage native led UAA to its third straight top-2 regional seed and its second straight 30-win season (30-2), while recording the first 20-0 league record in GNAC history ... the previous season, McCarthy's crew set an NCAA Div. II record with 38 victories, advancing all the way to the 2016 National Title Game in Indianapolis ... his 2014-15 club claimed what was then the best winning percentage in program history with a 29-2 (.935) mark, sweeping both GNAC titles as well ...
